ORDER:

The following Notification shall be published in an Extra-Ordinary Issue of the Telangana State Gazette.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under rule 8 of the Telangana Law Courses (Regulation of Admissions into Post Graduate Law L.L.M/M.L. Course) through Common Entrance Test Rules, 2006 read with sub rule (V) of Rule 4 of the Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee for Professional courses offered in Private Un-aided (Minority/Non Minority) Professional Institutions Rules, 2006 issued in the G.O. 1st read above and adopted vide G.O. 3rd read above, and in pursuance of the resolution of the Committee (TAFRC) dated: 15.10.2022 received in the reference 3rd and 4th read above, the Governor of Telangana hereby notify the Fee structure for Post Graduate Law LLM / ML courses in Private Unaided Professional Colleges in the State of Telangana for the Academic Years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25, as indicated in the Annexure to this Order. The uniform fee College-wise for LLM / ML courses is shown in the Annexure appended to this Notification.

2. The following Special Fees for the academic years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 is fixed for P.G. Law LL.M/M.L (2 Years) courses :-

- (i) Rs.1,000/- as one-time payment per student at the time of admission towards Admission / Registration / Recognition fees and half of such amount of Rs.1,000/- so collected shall be remitted by the Institutions to the concerned University.
- (ii) Rs.1,000/- per annum per student during the 2 years Course towards the students related special services rendered by them as detailed below and the said amount shall be retained by the Institutions:-

(iii) Rs.500/- towards Library deposit by way of refundable caution deposit at the time of admission only as one-time payment.

3. Consequently Government hereby issues the following directions to all the concerned Private LL.M/M.L colleges:-

- (i) The students admitted to the course during the academic year 2022-23 shall continue to pay every year the same annual tuition fee as paid at the time of their admission till they complete the course.
- (ii) The students who were admitted in the college prior to the academic year 2022-23 shall continue to pay every year the same annual tuition fee at the rate existing at the time of their admission till they complete the course.
- (iii) The institution shall collect the tuition fee every year in advance only for that particular year either in a lumpsum or in instalments, if it so opts.
- (iv) The Institutions shall not charge any capitation fee or any amount unauthorisedly or illegally under any other head or guise (e.g., donation etc.), either directly or indirectly, other than the fee fixed by the Committee, as collection of any such unauthorized amounts would amount to charging of Capitation Fee, and that the surplus (profit) that is generated from the collection of the Fee must be for the benefit of the Institution, and cannot be diverted for other purposes or for personal gain.
- (v) The Institutions are informed that fixation of the Fee Structure by the Admission & Fee Regulation Committee will not by itself enable or permit the managements to run the relevant courses in their institutions, if they are otherwise not duly recognized and permitted by the Government or BCI / UGC / Concerned University / Government Department at any relevant time.
- (vi) The enhanced fee now being in respect of institutions whose proposals have been evaluated based on the details / figures furnished by them to TAFRC is subject to further physical verification. If it is found that the data given by the institution is not correct, the Fee shall be subject to change at a later date and this fact shall be informed to the University or Competent Authority concerned for taking necessary action in accordance with law.

- (vii) The institutions for whom tuition fee is not fixed shall not be entitled to collect any tuition fee during the block period 2022-2023 to 2024-2025.
- (viii) The above Tuition fee is fixed for the academic years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 subject to provision for neutralization of inflationary impact to the required extent at the beginning of the academic year 2022-23.
